
SNOW REMOVAL

HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL REMINDERS AND FACTS

- * PLEASE PARK OFF STREET IF POSSIBLE IN ANY SNOW EVENT IF YOU PARK YOUR CARS IN YOUR DRIVEWAY YOU HAVE VERY LITTLE SNOW TO SHOVEL.
- * PLEASE CLEAR END OF DRIVEWAY UPSTREAM WHEN PLOWING IS FINISHED.
- * STREETS WILL BE PLOWED CURB TO CURB WHEN POSSIBLE.
- * PUTTING SNOW ON A CLEARED ROADWAY IS NOT PERMITTED. VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED!
- * THERE WILL BE TIMES WHEN THE PLOW PUTS SNOW IN YOUR DRIVEWAY END, IT IS NOT DONE INTENTIONALLY.

- * OUR MAIN OBJECTIVE FOR PLOWING SNOW IS TO GET EMERGENCY VEHICLES IN TO HELP YOU IF NEEDED.
- * YELLOW CENTER LINE AND EMERGENCY STREETS ARE FIRST TO BE PLOWED AND KEPT OPEN DURING HEAVY SNOWS.
- * SECONDARY STREETS ARE PLOWED NEXT.
- * CUL-DE-SACS AND ALLEY'S ARE PLOWED LAST.
- * 1" TO 3" SNOW FALLS GET SALT ONLY.
- * 3" OR MORE ARE PLOWED.
- * THE BOROUGH HAS A SNOW REMOVAL PLAN/ MAP AND HAS KEPT IT UPDATED AS MORE STREETS ARE ADDED.
- * THE PLAN CAN BE VIEWED AT THE BOROUGH OFFICE DURING NORMAL WORKING HOURS.

Plow or shovel your snow to the side of your driveway, away from the flow of traffic. Clearing snow for a distance prior to your driveway allows the plow to "unload" before reaching it. By piling snow away from the direction of oncoming snowplows, the bulk of the snow will not be pushed back onto your driveway.

SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE

The East Petersburg Borough code requires that all snow shall be removed from sidewalks within four (4) hours after the end of a snowfall or by 10:00 AM if snow has fallen overnight. Failure to comply with this ordinance will result in prosecution. Fines not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00).
