BOROUGH OF EAST PETERSBURG ORDINANCE NO. 269

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 110 OF EAST PETERSBURG BOROUGH, REQUIRING THE OWNERS, OCCUPANTS OR TENANTS OF PROPERTY IN THE BOROUGH TO REMOVE SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS IN THE BOROUGH OF EAST PETERSBURG AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE COUNCIL OF BOROUGH OF EAST PETERSBURG, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains and enacts this Ordinance as follows:

<u>SECTION I</u>. Section 1 of the Borough of East Petersburg Ordinance No. 110 is hereby amended by deleting Section 1 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

The owner, occupant or tenant of any property fronting on or adjoining any street or alley in the Borough shall clear a pathway of at least three feet in width on the sidewalk in front of or adjoining such property within **twelve (12) hours** after the snow which is the cause thereof has ceased to fall or to be formed or after the same has been deposited thereon in any manner; No snow removed from any sidewalk shall be deposited in the street after the street has been plowed.

SECTION II. All other articles, sections, subsections and provisions of Ordinance No. 110 shall remain in full effect as previously enacted.
